Golf Rule Reminder

Rule 17.3 *No Relief under Other Rules for your ball in Penalty Area*

When your ball is in a penalty area, there is no relief for interference by an abnormal course condition (Rule 16.1), an embedded ball (Rule 16.3) or an unplayable ball (Rule 19). Your only relief is to take penalty relief under Rule 17. (You gotta love golf and its rules!)
