Lee Heuston played great golf from his 4 handicap to win Saturday's Monthly Medal with an excellent 68 nett, on a day where only 3 players scored below their handicap. The ever consistent David Matt won A Grade with his 69 nett score, with Peter Conroy (71) and David Kinch (72) filling the minor placings. Geoff Geason won B Grade with his 72 nett score, just ahead of Gary Musialak and Neil Jordan with their 73s. Steve Primmer picked up another prize in winning C Grade with his 69 nett score, well clear of runner up Matthew Bain with a 72 with Col Hughes very grateful to come third after his nett 79. The shot of the day belonged to Steve Kearney on the 2nd (a very small temporary green), landing his tee shot only 90 cms from the pin. Mark Moylan won the Pro NTP on the last, picking up a \$94 voucher for his tee shot. A nett 78 was needed to win a ball, showing how difficult stroke events can be, especially in the winter months.

Rule Reminder

Rule 18.3 When Provisional Ball is Allowed

If your ball might be **lost** outside a **penalty area** or be **out of bounds**, to save time you may play another ball provisionally under penalty of **stroke and distance**. **But** if you are aware that the only possible place your original ball could be **lost** is in a **penalty area**, a **provisional ball** is not allowed and a ball played from where the previous stroke was made becomes your ball **in play** under penalty of **stroke and distance**.
