Bob made it a great day by winning the Pro's NTP on the last worth \$108 after his shot finished just over a metre away. Andrew McGovern won B Grade with his Plus 2 just ahead of Robert Miller on Plus 1 with Eddie Garland's square result good enough for third. Murray Kingston won C grade in a very tight contest with his Plus 2 defeating Lennie Porter and Robert McMillan on the same score. A Minus 2 score (equivalent to 34 pts in a stableford) was needed to win a ball. The following "Notice to Members" was outlined on the Club's website last week-so please take note of the changes:

*Dear Members, the current Stay at Home orders put in place by the NSW State Government has impacted many things in relation to how golf is conducted at Branxton Golf Club. The Golf Operations Committee thanks members for their cooperation during this time. Many events planned for August, September and October have been affected. **As a result, a revised calendar for the Men's and Ladies Program of Events for the remainder of 2021 and early 2022 has been developed.** The program has been based on the prediction of the current NSW Stay at Home orders changing on 18 October 2021. Further changes may be required if this date changes. Key changes to note (full calendar on page 2): 1. The Men's Club Championships have been rescheduled to 20 – 21 and 27 – 28 November. 2. The Ladies Club Championships have been rescheduled to 17, 24 November and 1 December. 3. The Men's Foursomes Club Championships will be held on 4 December. 4. The Singles Knockout Final is to be played by 13 November. 5. The Pairs (Fourball) Knockout will run into Jan/Feb 2022. The remaining Round 1 and 2 matches are to be completed by 11 December. The Final is to be played by 5 February 2022. The remaining teams in this competition are encouraged to be proactive and play remaining matches as quickly as possible. 6. The 2021 Mixed Foursomes Club Championships will be played on 16 January 2022. 7. The Par 3 Championships will be played on 29 January 2022. 8. Presentation Night has been moved to 11 December and is subject to the rules regarding functions at indoor venues at that time. 9. The 2022 Summer Cup will be run as the best 3 rounds out of 4. If the 2021 Club Championships cannot be played in November, they will be rescheduled to early 2022. Unfortunately, the following events are cancelled for 2021: 1. KCE 6x6x6 Stableford event 2.
