Andrew Bercini produced one of the best rounds in recent memory to win Saturday's Monthly Medal with an outstanding 60 nett score—a 66 off the stick from his 6 handicap—4 under par. Andrew doesn't play regularly but his round denotes his ability with this game as he hits it some prodigious distances and obviously, judging by his overall score, put together all other parts of his game on Saturday. Bob Biles played very well to win A Grade with his 68 nett score, on a day where the course played long with longer rough also in play. Mick Tracey once again played well to finish runner up with his 70 nett score with Lee Heuston also displaying his talents to finish third on the same score—just in time for the upcoming Club Championships (Rounds 3 and 4). Bobby Hale won B Grade with a very pleasing 69 nett, just ahead of Geoff Jones and Trent McGee with their 70s. Glenn Fletcher won C Grade with his 71 nett, defeating Raymond Moeser on a countback with Barry Turner returning to form to finish third with his 72. A 75 nett score was needed to win a ball. The shot of the day and the Pro's NTP worth \$86 was won by Eddie Garland on the last, with his shot finishing only 71 cm from the pin—a great shot. The deferred Club Championships will be played next weekend with the Presentation Night planned for the 22nd of January
