Dave Kinch picked the right time to play so well, as he and Mick Carling combined together to defeat Ian Barnes and Andrew Bercini 3 and 2 in the Pairs Knockout final—now that is a great day of golf. Brendan Connor won B grade with his 38 pts, just ahead of Robert Hale, this year's B Grade runner up, with 37 pts, whilst the evergreen Gary Wilton turned back time to finish third with his very pleasing 36 pts. Andrew McGovern won C Grade with a very strong 41 pts, just ahead of Kel Mather and Mick Lutovac who both had 39 pts. Kel also won the nearest the pin on the 2nd/11th whilst the A Grade winner, Dave Kinch, hit the shot of the day at the 9th, finishing only 124 cm away. 33 pts was needed to win a ball.
