In A grade, Club Captain Steve Ross showed the way with an outstanding 43 points, equating to 76 off the stick, to take first place and the best score of the day. Robert Biles continues to play consistently with another below handicap score and NTP with a well compiled 37 points off his 6 handicap. Nick Wheeler mentioned that he thought he hadn't played all that well, but it was good enough for third with a steady 35 points. Neil Jordan had a great day, shooting 37 points to win B grade by 3 shots from Jack Budden on 34 points. Murray Kingston, fresh off his win on Thursday picked up third, also with 34 points. Luke Tarrant had a very good score of 38 points to take out C grade. Luke may not be in C grade much longer if he continues to produce rounds of this quality. Leanne Daniels had a slow start, but a tremendous back nine of 23 points saw her take out second place with 36 points, with Mathew Schnell third after a pleasing 35 points. Jeff Haywood has bragging rights for shot of the day after holing out for a 2 from distance on the par 4 8th hole. His match play opponent Peter Conroy commented that it made it a little bit tricky for him to square the hole as he had to give Jeff one shot on that hole, so he needed a hole in one to match his net score! Ben George's tee shot to win the NTP on the 13th was excellent, finishing inside 1 metre. The new 8th green is almost ready to be brought back into play and looks like being an excellent upgrade for the Branxton layout.
