Ed Garland led the way in B grade with a 73 nett, a score which also helped him and partner David Kinch have a big win in the pairs knockout over Robert Biles and Gary Walsh. Michael Carling's 74 nett was good enough for second place on a countback from Lee Jackson. Lenny Porter found form on the right day to easily take out C grade with 68 nett, three shots clear of new member Christian Thompson's solid 71 nett. Brett Trezise took third with 72 nett. Brett Hutley and Joe Bereza were clearly at one with The Force (check the date) as they chipped in on the 8th and 7th holes respectively. John Burgess clearly learnt from the lesson his grandson was giving him on the 9/18th hole on Friday afternoon, taking the NTP and Pro pin with a great shot to a back pin placement.

In other knockout results, Peter Conroy defeated Darrell Fleming in round 2 of the singles while club President Richard Crooks teamed up with Brett Trezise to defeat Steve Eccles and Robert Miller in round 1 the pairs.
