The Branxton Open weekend of golf kicked off with the 2BBB stableford plus singles event. Unfortunately, overnight and morning rain scared a few players away, leaving some groups with 3 players and the need to have a “swinger”. Despite the playing conditions a strong field turned up and the family pairing of Allan and Daniel Hutley took out the day's event with a solid team score of 43 points. Greg Tearle had a great day out, pairing up separately with his playing partners Norm Pringle and Neil Jordan to take 2nd and 3rd places respectively, with both pairs scoring 41 points. Greg also took out the single stableford in conjunction event with an excellent 38 points, along with a NTP and the Pro NTP to round off a great day's golf for a player not known to truly enjoy the wetter conditions. Lenny Porter has found a bit of good form in recent weeks and teamed with Mark Moylan to take 4th place on 40 points on a countback from Joe Bereza and Charles Jubb on the same score.

As is often the case in singles in conjunction events, at least one of the players from the winning pair(s) have also played well in the singles event, and today was no different. With Greg taking 1st place, Daniel Hutley was only one point behind on 37 in 2nd place and Joe Bereza a further point back to claim 3rd on 36. Matthew Schnell and Lee Heuston filled the remaining prize positions, both on 33 points. With NTP's for all three grades on each of the par 3 holes, there were plenty of novelty events to be won. Players are reminded to check the NTP sheets carefully to make sure that they are writing their names down on the correct sheet for their grade.

No knockout matches were played today. Competition on Saturday 29 June will be a red tee stableford event. Advance notice that the club mixed foursomes championships will be held on Sunday 21 July.
