In C grade, Ben George was first out on the course and battled the frost on the front nine and then had a great back nine to compile a very good 35 points and take first place. Josh Hare also had 35 points but had to settle for second place on countback. Robert Miller rounded off the placings with a solid 32 points. In the NTP's, Peter "Pedro" Mackenzie found the 2nd green to his liking to take the prize, while Bobby Hale hit a nice shot into the 4th hole. Marc McGee's shot on the 13th could not be beaten while Steve Eccles hit the shot of the day on the 18th to take the NTP and the Pro pin. In the pairs knockout played midweek, bad light stopped play with Cameron and Murray Johanson 1 up with two holes to play against Nick Wheeler and Geoff Jones, with the remainder of the match set to be played on Monday morning.
