Yellow and green balls were used, hitting them on alternate holes, with the yellow ball worth double the score (if lost, no double scores could occur). Errol Munzenberger and Wayne Oliver won the day with their 75 pts. As Errol was quoted saying, he had a 5/3 on the first—with the yellow ball—so it was worth 6 pts; similarly on the fifth where a 5/3 was worth 6 pts. The secret was to not lose that yellow ball—apparently George Anderson didn't read that memo as he hit his first shot out of bounds on the first hole so they had no double scores all day! Garry Taylor and Steve Condran were runners up, 3 pts back. Prizes were awarded down to 8th spot. Paul Johansen hit the best shot to the last.
