America Foursomes was the event, where the goal is to have a ball in a good position after 2 shots from each player. With some challenging pin and tee placements, low scores were well earned. Dean Clack teamed up with club captain Steve Ross and the pair combined really well all day to shoot the lowest round in the field off the stick (77) and take the overall prize with 65 nett. Runners up were Mark Faulkner and Kel Mather, who also combined well to shoot a sub par round of 68.5 nett. Tim Lane and Luke Tarrant saw all parts of the course but held their nerve when it mattered to post a score of 69.37 nett to run third. Less than 1 shot behind in fourth place were Mick Barrett and David Kinch with a par round of 70 nett. They were happy to win the KENO ticket off their playing partners Ed Garland and Neil Jordan, who were an agonizing 0.25 shots behind in fifth on 70.25. Neil and Ed had the highs and lows of foursomes golf, with Neil having shot of the day on the 2nd hole to win the NTP with 56cm, leaving Ed with a short putt, while Ed “returned the favour” by leaving Neil an interesting second shot on the 15th hole down by the creek near the 2nd green. Geoff Jones and Nick Wheeler took sixth place with 72.25. Gary Walsh, who has been instrumental in keeping the KCE Day and annual event, teamed up with regular partner Robert Miller to take 7th place with 74 nett. Mick Carling had a good day on the par 3's, winning the NTP on the 4th and 9th holes, while Murray Kingston was the best on the 13th hole. David Kinch won another Pro NTP on the last, with a solid iron shot to 246cm. Balls went to all other players. The club would like to thank KCE for their ongoing support of Branxton Golf Club.
