Cool and foggy conditions greeted the field for the 2 ball stableford multiplier event, one which has not been held since 2023. On a day where each player tries to score at least 1 point on every hole, the number of times "sorry" was heard on the course today meant that quite a few team scores of zero points were recorded due to a player scoring zero. At the other end of the scale, there were also quite a few 8, 9 and even 12 point team holes recorded when both players had a great hole. Graham Bull and James Elphick had the right number of good scoring holes to offset the zero holes and post the winning score of 70 points. Ian Howell teamed up with Mick Martin and their steady golf helped them score 66 points to take second place. Peter Mackenzie and Garry Taylor also combined well together, coming third with a sound 62 points. Peter Conroy and Murray Kingston are clearly getting ready for the pairs knockout, teaming up in 4th place with 60 points. In the singles event, Peter Conroy overcame a severe blowout in one of his golf shoes on the back nine to post an excellent winning score of 39 points. Apparently, his playing partner had to lend him some electrical tape to put his shoe back together so that it would stay on his foot! Ian Howell continued his solid run of form to place second with 38 points, with Craig Howe in third place with 37 points on a countback from Chris O'Brien. In Round 2 of the singles knockout, the players in the two matches played today were in the same group, and both matches had exactly the same ending by finishing on the 1st extra hole – a rare event. Robert Biles defeated Mark Moylan in a very even contest, while Steve Eccles outlasted Mick Barret. Robert and Steve both won the 18th hole to force the extra holes and then both players were able to close out their match on the 19th hole.
