The large majority of the field of 53 found it very tough going in today's stableford event. Despite the course being in excellent condition players found it difficult to post high scores, with two thirds of the field not making it to 30 points. In A grade, Toby Grant won his first competition in quite a while, posting a very good 35 points. Two points further back was the ever steady Greg Tearle on 33 points, who took second place over Mick Barrett, also on 33 points, on a countback. Mick Martin showed the way in B grade, also winning with a score of 35 points. Mick had the shot of the day after an excellent tee shot on the 9th hole to win the NTP with 79cm, and he didn't waste it by going on and sinking the birdie putt. Murray Johanson found a bit of form to post 33 points in second place, with Andy Keogh warming up for the pairs knockout with Katelyn coming third with 31 points. Riley Kirkman was the only player to better his handicap today, showing everyone how it was done with an impressive 37 points to have the best score of the day and win C grade. James Elphick continues to play well at the moment, placing second with 33 points. Geoff Geason put last week's round behind him to take third place with 30 points. Robert Biles took the NTP on the 2nd hole this week with a solid shot to 226cm, while Steve Ross' tee shot on the 4th was one of the few good spots of his round today, but good enough to win the NTP. Murray Johanson hit a solid rescue club on the 13th to win the NTP there. Tim Lane finished well and took the Pro NTP on the last hole. No singles knockout matches were played today, and the pairs knockout draw has been completed and will be available on the website and posted in the clubhouse.
