As the wind picked up his game improved, scoring 37 off the stick on the back nine. Steve Eccles was another to have a solid day out, winning A grade with a very handy 72 nett. There was at least one triple bogey in that score, so he was thereabouts for the remainder of his round. Mick Simpson returned to competition play with a solid 75 nett to take second place on a countback from David Kinch in third on the same score. The B grade division was fairly close despite the higher scoring. Graham Cole was out early and set the benchmark at 76 nett and it turned out to be enough to win the grade. Geoff Jones was one shot back in second on 77 nett, with Bob Hale in third on 78 nett. Jeremy Brown had a fantastic first competition round to easily win C grade with an excellent 68 nett, including a birdie on the 12th hole. He was 5 shots clear of playing partner Kyden Maytom on 73 nett on a countback from the May medal winner Ed Garland on the same score. Mick Carling won the prize for landing your tee shot nearest to John Burgess' back fence off the 1st tee, while Kel Mather is apparently still wondering where his tee shot on the 16th landed after a slight miscue and unfortunate rebound off the railings on the steps. Ben Porter took the NTP on the 2nd hole with a great shot to 274cm, while Steve Ross landed his tee shot on the 13th in a great position, only 115cm from the pin, to take shot of the day. Neil Jordan raised the bat today, but a great shot on the last to take the NTP and Pro NTP had him smiling back in the clubhouse.
