Overcast but calm conditions greeted the field today for the second red tee event of the year. While many holes on the red course are similar to the white course, having the change of scenery on some of the holes doesn't hurt from time to time. In A grade, Club Captain Steve Ross showed the way with a well compiled score of 36 points to take the win. Steve Eccles took second place with 35 points on a countback from Greg Tearle on the same score. Greg commented that unlike his playing partners he quite enjoyed the red course today as he played really well on it. Robert Hale had a nice return to form to take out B grade with an impressive 38 points. He had an excellent back nine of 21 points, which included a "wipe" on the 11th hole and a chip in for birdie on the 12th. Three players in B grade shot 37 points, with Paul Johansen having the better back nine to take second place on a countback from Neil Bridge in third and Dean Fowler in fourth. In C grade Lee Jackson "lost" his swing last week but today it was on song as he took first place with 36 points. Pip Lancaster was back in action and lost out to Lee on a countback to place second with 36 points, with Robert Miller, who has been playing steady golf of late, taking third on 32 points. Murray Kingston hit a beautiful iron into the 11th hole to 77cm to win the NTP and shot of the day honours. Steve Ross almost holed out on the 4th hole to take the NTP there, while Peter Conroy found his range on the 13th hole. Greg Tearle took the NTP on the 9th hole, while Bill Davies, returning after some time away, finished well on the 18th to take the Pro NTP.

No knockout matches were played today. The next round of matches for both knockouts are due to be played by 2/8/25. In July we have the club mixed foursomes championships on Sunday 13/7/25, and the rescheduled 2 man ambrose club championship event on 26/7/25.
