A lovely winter's day greeted the 51 golfers in today's stableford event. With the greens currently playing a bit tricky, a pair of steady hands around each green is needed to negotiate a good score. For the third time in the past seven weeks the course rated +2 in the daily difficulty rating, indicating that the course is playing much tougher than normal. In A grade Mark Moylan proved to be the most consistent in the grade, taking the win with 35 points. Steve Ross scored a handy 34 points to take second, with Peter "Pedro" Mackenzie taking third with 33 points. Pedro was most pleased that he had also picked up the NTP on the 4th hole as he commented that he needed to replenish his golf ball supply. In B grade, Robert Hale started off a bit shaky but came home with an incredible 25 points on the back nine (his 37 off the stick was his best ever for the back nine) to post the score of the day with 42 points. There were plenty of golfers checking to see if he had counted all of his putts! Bob was 10 points clear of Peter Conroy in second place with 32, with Neil Bridge a further 2 points back on 30 in third, taking it on a countback from Murray Kingston. Sam Bridge is making the most of playing more Saturday golf, taking out C grade with a solid 34 points. Pip Lancaster came second with 33 points, including a pretty honest description of a wayward tee shot on the 10th hole. Gary Walsh held onto his good form from last week to post 32 points for third place. In the NTP's Robert Biles set the bar early on the 2nd hole and nobody could better his 297cm. Andrew Keogh found the 13th hole to his liking today to take the NTP with 620cm. Ben Porter struggled for most of the day but found a great shot to finish with on the 18th, taking the NTP and Pro NTP.

No knockout matches were played today. More matches for the pairs knockout have been scheduled for 2/8/25. Congratulations to Cameron and Karen Johanson who took out the mixed foursomes championships on 13/7/25. Next Saturday 26/7/25 is the 2 man ambrose club championships. In August the men's foursomes championships will be held on the 9th and the rescheduled Par 3 championships will be held on the 30th. The Tooheys Day advertised for Sunday 17/8/25 has been postponed.
