The rescheduled 2 Man Ambrose Championships, sponsored by Mitchell Olsen at Urban Real Estate were held today after being postponed in May due to extreme weather. The early morning rain threatened to muck things up again, but thankfully conditions cleared around 10am and a pleasing field of 58 players were able to complete their round in pleasant conditions. Current club champion Cameron Johanson teamed up with his nephew and junior member Kyran Reynolds to post an excellent scratch score of 1 under 69 to win the club championship event for 2025. His playing partner and proud dad Murray said that Cameron hit 17 of 18 fairways/greens off the tee which set them up in strong positions all day. Murray commented that young Kyran showed no fear with his short game, helping the team to post the winning score. The nett winners were Peter “Pedro” Mackenzie and Mark Moylan with an excellent score of 65 nett. This was a strong team on paper and despite Pedro’s claims that Mark carried him, they still had to combine well to post the winning nett score. The club champions and nett winners both receive presentation night prizes. Mick Barrett and David Kinch played well together to post a scratch score of 72 to take the runners up prize in the scratch event. Darrell Fleming and Matthew Schnell also had a great day out, playing better than their handicap to take runners up in the nett event with 66.25. The daily event saw Darren Gilroy and Kyle Mounser take nett third with 66.75, including a great recovery on the 11th hole after the “best” tee shot was in the trees to the left of the creek. Ben Bridge combined with his father Neil to take nett fourth place with 67 nett, with Reece Caldwell and Chris Zawirski taking out the remaining prize in nett 5th place with a score of 67.5. Chris had a great finish to his round, taking the Pro NTP on the last, even though he may have thought his shot to 505cm might not have held out the rest of the field.

The Johanson boys almost had a clean sweep of the NTP's, with Murray taking it on the 2nd hole and Cameron showing his class on the 4th and 9th holes with great shots to two strong hole locations. James Elphick took the prize on the 13th hole.
