In the daily stableford event, Ben Porter rocketed back to form with an excellent 40 points to win A grade. Chris Zawirski had another very good day to take second with 39 points. Robert Biles also found some form to take third place with 38 points. The next best in A grade had 33 points, so it was an impressive show from these three golfers. Murray Johanson, who has worked tirelessly over the past 2 weekends with course maintenance, finished strongly to take out B grade with 37 points on a countback from Ben George. Ben had 38 off the stick on the front nine, and this allowed him to jump up into 3rd place in the championships. Mick Barrett has been very consistent for a few weeks and today was no different with his steady 36 points. In C grade, the players in the seeded group took out the prizes today. Joe Bereza had the best score with 34 points, with Andrew George one point back on 33. Ian Howell won third with 32 points on a countback from Sam Bridge. Dean Clack almost had one of the best pars on the 11th hole. After hitting his tee shot into the creek, he chose to go again from the tee and almost holed his next attempt. He made the putt for an impressive 4 (and a second ball birdie). Mark Moylan had some unfortunate luck today with not being able to find tee shots, returning twice to the tee to show his skills to the group waiting behind him. Nick Redgrove wins the recognition award for consistent effort over the championships. He had the same score for the first three rounds and his round 4 score was one shot higher (I will let Nick tell you what his scores were (c)). Mick Barrett found his range on the 2nd hole, hitting it to 90cm to take the NTP, while Ben George's great front nine included the NTP on the 4th hole. Chris Zawirski was probably the only person to find the 13th green today for his NTP of 900cm, while Greg Tearle took the 9th hole with 276cm.
