The 2026 Summer Cup started on Saturday in hot and windy conditions for all players, with a shotgun start being used to beat the forecast extreme heat. The recent run of warm weather continues to dry out the fairways, leading to plenty of run, while the tees and greens are being well maintained by the great group of volunteers who water them twice a day. In the Summer Cup, Geoff Jones leads the way with 38 points. Joint winners from 2025, Steve Eccles and Robert Miller, have no intention of letting their title go easily and are both in equal second place on 36 points, along with 2025 Mug of Mugs winner Ed Garland. As he did last year, Steve Eccles won A grade in Round 1 with his 36 points. In second place was Ben Porter with a sound 33 points, including a birdie on his last hole today, the 1st. Anyone still on the course certainly heard his celebration after sinking a 10 metre birdie putt. Tim Whitney played steady golf to post 31 points and pick up third place. Geoff Jones won B grade with 38 points. He had 19 points on each nine representing some consistent golf all day. Ed Garland enjoyed getting around in the heat today in a cart and posted a good score of 36 points to take second. Malcolm Crossley had a tremendous back nine of 21 points on his way to posting 35 points in third place. In C grade, Robert Miller took the win with 36 points after battling it out all day with cart partner Steve Eccles. Steven Primmer was another to have a very good back nine, scoring 20 points on his way to second place with 35 points overall. Andrew George took third place with 32 points. In the NTP's David Kinch hit a great iron shot into a back pin on the 2nd/11th to take the prize with 151cm. An admin mix up meant that there was no NTP available today on the 4th and 13th holes. It was reported that Zac Henry stuck it very close on the 4th hole, so he is a little unlucky to miss out today. Unfortunately, he missed the birdie putt but made a comfortable par. One of new regular junior players, Carter Swan took the prize on the 9th/18th with 383cm, and his just beaten out of the Pro NTP by Mark Moylan, who was the only player to get closer with 231cm to take the pro shop voucher. Club President Murray Johanson has been helping our new junior players Kyran Reynolds and Carter and Caleb Swan learn the ways of playing competition golf and has been very impressed with their attitude and willingness to learn about the rules as things happen on the course.

The Summer Cup leader board is below. With the best 3 rounds out of 4 format an early lead is helpful but is no guarantee of overall success. While some players will be hoping that their round today won't be counted in their best three, it only takes one very good round to put you back in the mix.

Rounds 2, 3 and 4 of the Summer Cup continue over the next three Saturdays.
