Cooler conditions were welcomed by the field of 55 players for the first par event of the year. Par can be brutal on the scoring, and for some players the “Pick Up” button on the scoring computer can often get a good workout. With the course playing well there were opportunities to make a high score, and our winners today showed how it could be achieved. In A grade, Mark Moylan had a great day out to post a very good score of +4 and take the win. Allan Jack was playing a rare Saturday round and also shot a great score +4 but had to settle for second place after a countback. Andrew “Basil” Bercini had a great back nine on his way to posting a score of 0 and 3rd place. Andrew also took out the NTP’s on the 13th and 18th holes, along with the ProNTP. In B grade, Katelyn Keogh won her first par event with a solid round of +4. Current club junior champion Kyran Reynolds took second place with +2 on a countback from Norm Redgrove on the same score. As is common in par events, the C grade field put up the best scores of the day. Mark Faulkner had a day to remember with an outstanding score of +8 to take the win. He posted +4 on each nine and only posted two “minuses” in his round – well done. Caleb Swan continues to improve and on any other day his +7 would have been a winning score, however he had to settle for second place today. Darrell Fleming was another player to post +4 and was enough to take third place. Darrell started off well and slowly built on his good start as the round progressed. In the other NTP’s Steve Eccles had the closest NTP today with his 237cm to win on the 2nd/11th, while Nick Redgrove was the closest on the 4th hole with 357cm. Murray Johanson takes the award for the most interesting tee shot of the day on the 11th hole. Off the tee he managed to hit the plaque (possibly the smallest target to hit on the course 😊) on the halfway house that sits under the eaves and ricochet up into the roof.

Next Saturday 21/2/26 is a stableford event, with the KCE Day on 28/2/26 an American Foursomes pairs event. The nature of the foursomes event means that you can only play with one partner, so make sure you find a partner for this event.

Rule Clarification

With the temporary green in play on the 1st/10th holes, the area beyond the roped off area is GUR and players should use the nearest drop zone (free relief) in front of the ropes if their ball stops in the GUR.

EXCEPTION – If a player's ball ends up in the penalty area in the GUR, then the penalty area status supersedes GUR, meaning you cannot get free relief. Your options are to either play the ball as it lies or use the drop zones with a 1 shot penalty.
