Scratch winners were the team of Geoff Jones and Mark Moylan with a score of 79. Geoff and Mark had a great back nine of 39 to take the win on a countback from two other teams. All other prizes were determined on nett scores, with Doug Elphick and Graham Bull taking first place, combining very well to post a very good nett score of 64.87. Ray Moeser teamed up with Ben Porter and played their way into second place with 66.5. Ben was particularly excited after the team scrambled a very good par on the 5th hole. Ben Bridge and Nick Redgrove were only 0.12 shots back in third place. The remaining prize winners (positions 4, 5 and 6) all shot nett scores in the 68's, with the rest of the field all taking home a ball. The pins on the par 3's were relatively hard to get close to today, with Robert Biles the best of the bunch hitting it to 163cm on the 9th. Hannah Wilson won her first competition NTP with a good shot to the 18th. Dean Clack hit a great shot into the 4th to take the NTP with 381cm. Mark Moylan got it closest to a tricky front pin on the 2nd with 450cm, while visitor Brett Newton showed the members how to do it on the 13th hole with a strong iron shot to 508cm. Craig Howe had the win in the Pro NTP on the last hole with 266cm.
