Ben Porter and Mick Barrett were a little unlucky today as they also scored 37 points but had to settle for a ball when on most other days they would have been on the podium. Robert Hale won B grade with 36 points on a countback. Once he gets his putter sorted out watch out A graders. Ian Howell took second with his 36 points. He was another to shoot 21 points, but on the front nine. Geoff Geason had a well made 34 points to take third place. Lee Jackson had a great day out, shooting 20 points on each nine to win C grade with 40 points. His long putt from just off the green on the 13th hole was a highlight. In second place was Carter Swan on 38 points. Carter has spent a lot of the school holidays on the course, and it paid off for him today. In third place was Maison Pearce with 35 points, one of his best competition rounds ever. In the NTP's, Bill Davies took the prize for the 2nd hole with 233cm. The 4th and 13th greens were hard to hit today, but Zac Henry and Greg Tearle managed to do it better than anyone else with 842cm and 1050cm respectively. Robert Miller hit a great iron shot on the 18th to take the NTP and Pro NTP with 175cm, and finished his round off in style by sinking the birdie putt.
